The University considers an applicant's whole profile (including band choices, preferred subjects and interview performance, etc.), in addition to the HKDSE score. As such, satisfying the university admission requirements does not guarantee admission.

Students with Alternative Qualifications in Chinese Language (ACL) are not included in the calculation of score.

Remarks

^The University has continued to adopt flexible admissions arrangements in the 2025/26 academic year and expanded this to programmes under the Non-means-tested Subsidy Scheme for Self-financing undergraduate studies in Hong Kong (NMTSS). Except for JS9580, JSSU40, JSSU50 and JSSU55, the arrangements has applied to all candidates who wish to apply for 2025/26 HKMU undergraduate programmes under both the Study Subsidy Scheme for Designated Professions/Sectors (SSSDP) and the NMTSS via the Joint University Programmes Admissions System (JUPAS). Under the arrangements, JUPAS applicants who fail to achieve Level 3 in either Chinese or English may still be considered by the University, provided that they attain a score of not lower than Level 2 in the subject in which they underperformed and achieved Level 5* or above in one other category A subject. The candidates' total HKDSE score must still meet the minimum expected admission score of their preferred programme, and they must place the programme in their Band A choice in JUPAS and pass an interview.
