JUPAS Announces 2026 Main Round Offer Results

The Joint University Programmes Admissions System (JUPAS) Office will announce the 2026 JUPAS Main Round offer results on 5 August 2026 (9:00 am). The 2026 admissions exercise recorded 45,545 applicants, an increase of 2,276 applicants, or about 5.26%, from 43,269 in 2025. A total of 20,598 applicants will receive Main Round offers through JUPAS participating-institutions and institutions participating in the Study Subsidy Scheme for Designated Professions/Sectors (SSSDP), representing 45.23% of all applicants, compared with 20,712 applicants, or 47.87%, in 2025.

The results will be released through SMS using the Registered SMS Sender ID “#JUPAS” and applicants’ JUPAS accounts. Applicants may also access the JUPAS Online Application System through the designated icon on the websites of the nine JUPAS participating-institutions. As the SMS will contain the Main Round offer results, applicants are not required to log in to their JUPAS accounts immediately upon the release of the results. Between 9:00 am and 10:29 am, applicants who log in to their JUPAS accounts may view their offer results only, while other account functions will be temporarily suspended. All account functions will resume normal operation from 10:30 am onwards. Applicants receiving Main Round offers must pay the acceptance fee by 5:00 pm on 6 August 2026 and follow the instructions in their JUPAS accounts to complete the registration / enrolment procedures required by the institution offering them admission.

Applicants who are given a Main Round offer will receive only ONE offer from their confirmed programme choice lists. The offer will be one of the following: a UGC-funded programme, an HKMU self-financing programme, or an SSSDP programme. Applicants who do not accept their Main Round offers by the specified deadline will be regarded as having declined the offers and, except for eligible applicants who submit requests for reconsideration of applications based on upgraded RR results, will not be reconsidered for admission to any other programmes under JUPAS in the same academic year.

Band Distribution of Main Round Offers

Overall, 16,739 applicants, representing 81.27% of all Main Round offers, will receive offers for programmes placed in Band A of their confirmed programme choice lists. In 2025, 16,923 applicants, or 81.71% of all Main Round offers, received Band A offers.

Offers through SSSDP institutions cover SSSDP full-time bachelor's degree programmes.



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Applicants who Have Applied for Rechecking and Remarking of HKDSE Examination Results (RR Results)

Applicants who have received Main Round offers and intend to accept them are advised to do so during the designated period.

Applicants who obtain higher subject levels or grades after rechecking and remarking may submit, a one-time only, free-of-charge request for reconsideration of their applications based on upgraded RR results via their JUPAS accounts from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm on 13 August 2026, regardless of whether they have received or accepted Main Round offers. Where applicable, applicants may modify their programme choices when submitting the request.

Applicants may also submit a one-time paid resubmission request on the same day by 6:00 pm upon payment of a fee of HK\$250. Late submissions are not accepted under any circumstances.

Bad Weather and “Extreme Conditions” Arrangements

If Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above, the Black Rainstorm Warning Signal, or “Extreme Conditions” announced by the HKSAR Government are in effect on 5 August 2026 (9:00 am), the arrangements for the announcement of the Main Round offer results will remain unchanged.
